Non – Food vendor spaces, primarily for arts & crafts dealers, will be available in Spainhower Park (Lone Pine Park). Please note a “Food Court” will be provided for visitors in the middle of the park.

Spaces will cost \$100.00 and are 10’ x 10’ in size. We do not provide tables and/or chairs for vendors so please plan your needs accordingly. A professional presentation of merchandise and space is expected.

Set-up hours begin Thursday afternoon, after 12:00 noon to 6:00 PM. Sales may be conducted Friday (9:00 AM to 6:00 PM), Saturday (9:00 AM to 7:00 PM) and Sunday (9:00 AM to 3:00 PM).

Spaces are limited and will be provided on a “first-come-first-serve” basis. Make your reservations early. A vendor application is attached and should be forwarded to:
