ART IN THE PARK VENDOR SPACE APPLICATION **FOOD VENDOR**

All of the food booths will be coordinated in a "Food Court" in the middle of Spainhower Park. The food court is surrounded by Arts and Crafts vendor booths.

Spaces will cost \$100.00 and are 10' x 10' in size. If you have a vending truck or anything over 10'X10' you need to reserve and pay for 2 spaces. We do not provide tables and/or chairs for vendors so please plan your needs accordingly. A professional presentation of merchandise and space is expected.

Set-up hours begin Thursday afternoon, after 12:00 noon to 6:00 PM or Friday 8:00 -9:00 AM. Sales may be conducted Friday (9:00 AM to 6:00 PM), Saturday (9:00 AM to 7:00 PM), and Sunday (9:00 AM to 3:00 PM).

Spaces are limited and will be provided on a "first-come-first-serve" basis. Make your reservations early. As a Food Vendor, you will be required to provide a Certificate of Insurance from your insurance company. The certificate should name the Museum of Western Film History as being added to your coverage during the days you are participating in the festival. Once we receive your application, Certificate of Insurance and check, we will mail you a vendor confirmation. Confirmations for park vendors will include the park rules and a map of the park.

Inyo County Department of Environmental Health requires all food vendors to submit a Temporary Food Facility Application, and obtain a Temporary Food Facility Permit. Your Vendor Space will be open Friday 9:00 AM to 6:00 PM, Saturday 9:00 AM to 7:00 PM from 9:00 AM to 6:00 PM, and Sunday from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM. You will be responsible for manning your space. If you leave during the vendor hours, you must arrange for coverage of your table.

BREAKDOWN OF SPACE: You MUST have all your items removed by 5:00 PM Sunday.
All vendors will be at Spainhower Park (Lone Pine Park) at the North end of town.
